

Public Attendance at Board Meetings of the Marquette Food Co-op

At this time, board meetings are held virtually the third Tuesday of each month at 6pm. Owners of the Marquette Food Co-op are welcome to attend. Below is some information about how board meetings are administered.

- Please arrive prior to 6pm. Owners may remain for the entire meeting or are welcome to leave at any time.
- When the Board is discussing agenda items, we ask that you listen quietly and not interrupt during discussions and voting. There are three public comment periods to allow the public the time and space for comments and questions.
- The Board values owners' questions and feedback. Questions and feedback relevant for the Board of Directors will be discussed at the following board meeting. The board speaks with one voice, so it is essential they have time for internal conversation before directly answering questions and concerns.
- Questions and feedback that are deemed non-board related will be directed to the General Manager for a response or next steps.
- Attendees may be required to leave if the Board enters a closed or executive session for the purpose of discussing personnel, legal, financial, real estate, or other confidential or sensitive matters. Attendees may rejoin the meeting when the closed session is concluded.
